**BRANDING: SIGNAGE & MATERIALS & DEMONSTRATIONS**

Signs. Each candidate can put up three 2x3’ signs, which can be placed in the Wetlands Cafe and hallways in front of the theatre and leading to the Wetlands Cafe. Signs must be posted with blue painter’s tape. Please note: no campaign signs are allowed in the theatre. Please remove your signs at the end of the convention. Thank you!

Stickers. Please, these cannot be placed anywhere except on humans--delegates, activists, supporters! We are guests of Eisenhower Community Center. Let’s be respectful!

Literature. Literature may be distributed in the Wetlands Café. As stated in our proposed rules: “Campaign literature may not be distributed in the convention theatre after balloting has begun.” All literature must be removed after the convention. The arrangements committee thanks you :)

Demonstrations. "No moving demonstrations are permitted during balloting. There shall be no disruptive demonstrations in the galleries. Each delegation will be responsible for collecting materials and garbage. Whistles, air horns, bull horns, and strobe lights or other similar devices will not be allowed during the convention in the convention hall."

**FLOOR PASSES**

Each campaign will receive up to five (5) floor passes. Check-in at the VISITORS table in the registration area.

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
